What's changing

With the 2024R2 release, Workday has introduced Page Builder within App Builder. This new feature allows developers to create extend pages using a simple point-and-click interface, eliminating the need for JSON coding. Users can now design pages effortlessly with drag-and-drop and click options. Rearranging widgets or sections within the page body is now simpler than ever. You can drag and drop elements anywhere, removing the need to worry about commas and brackets in JSON coding.

Additional considerations

Workday enables this feature with the existing manual creation, where you can toggle between JSON coding and Page builder view.





You can use the WQL code to retrieve data and insights from the relevant data sources.

The service uses Machine Learning models and a tenanted knowledge graph to generate the recommendations.





O4I : Orchestrate StarterKit: General integration service (OSK)



What's changing

Orchestrate StarterKit (or "OSK" as we call it) is a little different than the typical Orchestrate for Integrations app. Most integration apps are built to be run end-to-end and perform a very specific task related to a particular vendor or functional area. For example, import time blocks from a third-party time tracking system.OSK, on the other hand, doesn't do just that "one thing". It can help you with that task, but it does much, much more. OSK's purpose is to help you build your apps better, and faster.

OSK acts as the starting point for each of your Orchestrate for Integrations apps. There are common "best practices", or maybe rather "good patterns", that integration apps should follow. If they are so common though, why should you have to build them, from scratch, in every new app?

By starting your app from OSK, you automatically inherit these patterns and have access to pre-built, ready-to-use, already-tested solutions for common Orchestrate for Integrations tasks. This amounts to savings in development, testing, and support. You can write integrations faster because you don't have to write everything. You can test faster and more reliably because large chunks of code were already tested. You can save time in support because there is more consistency across all of your integration apps.






