

Case Study: Healthcare

Innovative healthcare analytics company enables remote productivity with cloud solutions

Scaling quickly, securely and cost effectively

With an initial remote workforce of approximately 100, the company quickly needed to scale up to handle 2,000 or more remote workers. It was already somewhat familiar with the AWS Cloud and currently using it as a development platform to build new applications.

At a glance

A leading healthcare analytics and technology company needed to support more than 2,000 remote users and enable continuing growth. It wanted a highly scalable, secure solution with the flexibility of a pay-per-use model.

Cognizant helped the company scale up its remote working capacity at a significantly lower cost by providing a completely managed, highly available and secure desktop-as-a-service (DaaS) solution based on AWS Cloud and Amazon WorkSpaces.

Reduced total cost of ownership (TCO) by approximately 30% in just six months. Due to industry economic pressures, the company also needed to minimize capital expenditures and reduce ongoing operational costs. In addition, it needed to meet rigorous industry security and privacy regulations for health-related data. The existing on-premises infrastructure didn't have the flexibility to scale quickly and easily, and it couldn't onboard new users within an acceptable timeframe.

The company looked to Cognizant for guidance in finding a highly secure infrastructure that could support more than 2,000 user desktops and 250 applications cost effectively in less than six months.

Leveraging the power of **AWS Cloud and Amazon** WorkSpaces

After a thorough evaluation of the client's needs and an assessment of its existing infrastructure, Cognizant proposed a solution built on the AWS Cloud and Amazon WorkSpaces. Through Amazon WorkSpaces, Cognizant provided a managed, highly secure DaaS solution. All workspaces are hosted on a public cloud, with access limited only to client devices. The company can provide workspaces to its end users anywhere, at any time and on any desktop—with automated and selfservice provisioning.

Amazon WorkSpaces quickly proved to be the ideal answer to the company's need for both on-demand scalability and reduced operational costs. Remote desktops can be set up for thousands of users, and the company pays monthly or hourly and only for the workspaces it launches. The solution helps eliminate the complexity in managing hardware inventory, OS versions and patches, and virtual desktop infrastructure.

In addition, the cloud infrastructure satisfies another of the company's key requirements: providing extensive security and business continuity functions to safeguard its data. The AWS Cloud security and authentication features enable the company to manage identities, resources and permissions at scale. Administrators can securely and easily manage remote user access to all workloads and applications.

Before deploying the Amazon WorkSpaces environment, the company used a Citrix solution for virtualization and management. Cognizant easily integrated this solution into the AWS infrastructure so the company could continue to use certain features on which it relied.

Pleased with the performance of Amazon WorkSpaces, the company later added Amazon AppStream 2.0, a fully managed application streaming service that enables IT administrators to centrally manage desktop applications and securely deliver them to any computer. AppStream 2.0 is built on AWS and designed for the most security-sensitive organizations. Users gain a fluid and responsive experience with all applications, including GPU-intensive 3D design and engineering.

Achieving better outcomes with Cognizant's collaborative approach

Cognizant worked with the company to develop a clear IT and cloud migration strategy that was closely aligned with the organization's overall business goals. Strategic work included creating an IT operating model, evaluating cloud platforms and tools, reviewing third-party best-in-class products and developing a proof of concept.
